A list showing merchandise packed, a copy of which is sent to the consignee to help verify the shipment. Often used as part of the order picking and processing.	A contract between an ocean carrier and a shipper arranging for carriage of freight. It provides evidence of the carrier's receipt of the cargo and lists the origin and destination ports, rates, quantities, weight, and any special handling requirements. The shipper is responsible for all losses other than for negligence on the part of the ocean carrier.
A freight document that indicates goods have been received for shipment by rail. The shipper receives a copy as a receipt for acceptance.	A quote provided by a seller/exporter prior to the delivery of products or services, informing the buyer/importer of the price. This document is submitted to customs for valuation purposes.
