It indicates the carrier's name and lists the master bill of lading. See: bill of lading (master).</div>

<div>Module 6</div> <div>Section H: Conduct Transportation Administration</div> <div>Term</div> <div>Consolidation</div> <div>APICS CLTD Learning System © 2025</div>	<div>The grouping of shipments to obtain reduced costs or improved utilization of the transportation function. Consolidation can occur by market area grouping, grouping according to scheduled deliveries, or using third-party pooling services such as public warehouses and freight forwarders. Syn.: freight consolidation. See: milk run.</div>
